Allocation of use of the Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Premium

In the last financial year 2016/17 Lighthouse School received £3,500 literacy and numeracy catch up premium.

Lexia – total cost £5,400 over three years
Mathletics – cost £252 per annum
Speech and Language intervention
