- Drinks

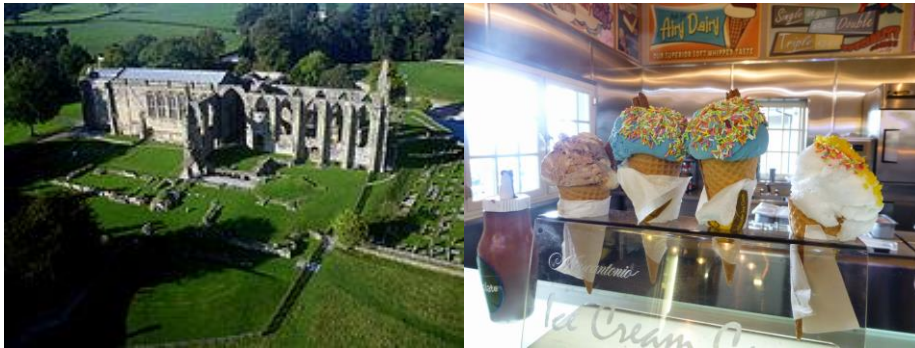
