Dear Parent/Carer,

We have received further guidance from Leeds Local Authority regarding the usage of face coverings in school. As current case numbers in Leeds remain high compared to other areas of the UK, Leeds Local Authority have advised students to continue wearing face coverings in communal areas of the school. We will notify you as and when this guidance changes. Face coverings are not required in the classroom. However, if your child still prefers to wear a mask/face covering in school then they can choose to do so.

We would also like to request that all students attend school each day wearing the Lighthouse school uniform, or their PE kit on days that they have PE on their timetable.

Government guidance states that educational visits are allowed to commence. These will be small visits to the local area and parents/carers will be notified prior to each visit.

Recommendation for twice weekly Lateral Flow testing remain in place, please contact reception if you require testing kits.

Finally, a reminder that students must not attend if they are displaying any symptoms of Coronavirus, if they are self-isolating following Government Guidance for households with family members displaying symptoms, if they have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or if they are required to quarantine having recently visited countries outside the common travel area.
