

Glossary of Exam Words

- Assessment Centre = Where you take the exam. School.
- Awarding body = the company that make the exams and give the marks/certificates out.
- Candidate/s = the student/s taking the exam.
- Candidate details = candidate number and centre number
- Candidate number = your own number. You will be given it before the exams
- Centre number = The number for the place you are taking the exam. It will be written at the front in the exam room if you can't remember it.
- Disqualified = You are stopped from taking part. This means your work is not accepted. It will not be marked. You don't get any score. You might not be able to take any other exams for that subject, or at all.
- Invigilator = a member of staff who is in the exam room. They say when the exam starts and finishes. They make sure everyone is keeping the exam rules.
- Marker = the person who marks your work
- Submit = hand in
